This has not only been a pleasure at Zauner since 1832 –
here it is culture!

The history of Konditorei Zauner, now over 190 years old, goes back to 1832, when the **founder Johann Zauner** was ordered to Bad Ischl by the at that time personal physician of the imperial family, doctor Franz Wirer, to open a pastry there to meet the imperial requirements.

In the days of the Austro-Hungarian monarchy, Zauner was allowed to serve as a purveyor to the imperial and royal court and provided culinary art to festivities at the Imperial Villa in Bad Ischl.

In 1905, the now world-famous **Original Zaunerstollen** was created by the bakery manager **Josef Nickerl**. It is still produced today according to the original recipe and in the traditional production method and is now sent all over the world.

The Zauner confectionery has received numerous awards throughout its history: These include the gold medal for the **Original Ischler Törtchen** as the world's best dessert at the World Exhibition in Brussels in 1958 and the state award by the Republic of Austria in 1980.

Over 30 pastry chefs bake the popular Zauner specialties fresh every day. The most popular creations from the Zauner bakery include: **Original Zaunerstollen, Original Bad Ischler Oblaten, Original Ischler Törtchen, Zaunerkipferl.**

In addition to the **main house in Pfarrgasse**, which exudes time-honored flair, the **Grand Café Restaurant Esplanade** is located on the banks of the Traun River. In addition to a well-balanced menu, it also offers a warm pastry menu with the most popular classics of Austrian pastry cuisine. The guest garden on the banks of the Traun invites you to linger.

In the main house in Pfarrgasse, you will find over 250 different sweet delicacies in the pastry display case: fresh-smelling pastry classics, seasonally changing creations, pralines and chocolate truffle as well as hand-molded chocolates are freshly prepared every day.

The online shop at **www.zauner.at** contains the majority of Zauner's sweet specialties, which are now shipped all over the world.

Today, the company is run by **Philipp Zauner**, now in the 7th generation of the family, and the top priority remains the same: Maintaining traditions, preserving the well-tried and tested and yet remaining open to the modern!

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
